Using Public Transportation in Vienna

Vienna is well known for its excellent public transportation system, which makes it easy to reach the conference. Using public transportation is convenient, efficient and safe. We will also use public transportation for the Excursion, reaching the 5 K run location, the BBQ and Banquet site.

A personalized pdf ticket covering public transport (including buses, metro trains, and trams) within the "Kernzone" (formerly Zone 100) of Vienna will be provided by the conference. This ticket will be sent to the participants by e-mail about two weeks before the start of the meeting and will be valid from Saturday, July 27 (0:00 am), until Saturday, August 3 (1:00 am). The ticket is only valid if you carry an identity card or passport with you.

Vienna provides an excellent public transportation system, including buses, trams, trains, and the subway system (https://www.wienerlinien.at/web/wl-en). To facilitate your travels, you can use the WienMobil app, accessible via their website at WienMobil

(https://www.wienmobil.at/en/monitor/PT), or download it from the App Store for Apple devices and the Play Store for Android devices. You can also use direction in google map


For participants from European Union countries, Internet access will be available via data roaming. For participants from other countries, free Internet access is available at Vienna Airport, on OEBB trains, in most hotels, and at the conference venue. For Internet access outside these locations, participants can make additional arrangements according to their needs, such as purchasing a local SIM card from local supplier such as T-Mobile, A1, Drei and Yess or purchase online SIM card using application such as AirAlo https://www.airalo.com/austria-esim.

How to purchase a ticket from airport to Vienna Center with OEBB website


The 7-day ticket provided by the conference will not cover the full distance from the airport to the city center of Vienna. Therefore, you will need to purchase an additional ticket (2,10 € for one way) in combination with your 7-day ticket for using local trains (not CAT, see below) to get to the city center.

To purchase train tickets from the OEBB website https://shop.oebbtickets.at/en/ticket?cref=google-kampagne-at-brand-app&pk campaign=paid-search do the following steps:


Step 1: State that you are going from "Flughafen Wien" to "Wien" and click find services




Step 2: Add a discount by pressing on the "1x Adult" button.




Step 3: The discount is called "Ticket Stadtverkehr Wien (Kernzone) excl. Jahreskarte", select it from the scroll down list.




Step 4: Now, you have the applicable discount, so find the train which can bring you in Vienna by clicking "find services".




Step 5. Select one-way tickets and day tickets.




Step 6: Select the suitable train time from the list.




Step 7: Confirm continue with 2,10 Euros




Step 8: Add your first name and last name and press confirm.




Step 9: Enter your email address and press on the payment method (i.e. credit card), then tick the square to proof that you read and understood the conditions and then press "pay now"




Step 10: Add your credit card details (credit card number, validity date and the security code (3 digit number of the back of your credit card)) and press "Buy".




Step 11: Then select how you would like to get your ticket, select as pdf, then press of create PDF ticket now



Step 12: The ticket will show up and then press of download/print PDF ticket.



Step 13: The ticket will show up as pdf ready for download for print or to be sent with WhatsApp or just take a snapshot and use it on the train when the controller ask for it. In this case you need to show the controller both the 7-days public ticket and this additional one you just purchase.



This was a long instruction and may feel complicated. But the Web site is guiding you easily through the process.

Alternative 1: You may use an OEBB ticket machine at the airport station and proceed accordingly.

Alternative 2: You may use the City Airport Train (CAT)

Important Note: The 7-day ticket is not valid on the CAT trains and you have to pay the full price (14,90 € for an one-way ticket) to use these trains. Tickets can be purchased at the airport.

How to reach the conference venue with public transport


The SIP Conference 2024 will take place at Campus Gusshaus of the Technical University of Vienna, located at **Gusshausstraße 27-29**, **A-1040 Vienna**. Public transportation stops next to the conference venue are "Taubstummengasse" (U1) (355 m), Karlsplatz (U1, U4) (600 m), or "Gußhausstraße" (tram 1 and D) (500 m).



How to reach the BBQ location with public transport

The BBQ will be held at the 'Brandauer Schlossbräu' brewery (https://www.bierig.at), Am Platz 5, 1130 Vienna, next to the Schönbrunn Castle. Participants of the excursions will be accompanied there by their guides. For all others, the easiest way to reach the BBQ location is using the U4 (the green Line) from "Karlsplatz" station to the "Hütteldorf" direction and leave the train at the "Hietzing" station. When leaving the station, make a left turn, cross the road, and continue walking for 2 min (~180 m). You will find the restaurant in from of you after crossing small road. If you arrive using the tram lines 10, 49, 52 or 60, exit at the station "Dommayergasse".


You may return from the BBQ at your convenience using again the underground or tram lines.



How to reach the 5 K run location

The 5K run will take place early Tuesday morning (6:30 am) in **Prater Hauptallee**, near the U1 "Praterstern" underground station. We will meet on July 30, early morning at 6:30 am in the Prater Hauptallee next to the Planetarium. The meeting point is just about 300 m from the Praterstern, a central traffic hub that can be reached by underground lines U1 and U2, trains of the S-Bahn (S1, S2, S3, S4, and S7), tram lines O and 5, and several bus lines (5B, 80A, and 82A).

After the run you may return to your hotel for taking showers and having breakfast. The start of the scientific programme is scheduled for 9:00 am.



How to reach the Banquet location with public transport

Thursday's banquet will be held at the The Arcotel Wimberger Hotel, **Neubaugürtel 34-36, 1070 Vienna** (https://wimberger.arcotel.com/en/) in the city center. Public transportation stops next to the Arcotel Wimberger Hotel are underground station "Westbahnhof" (U3 and U6) and many other tram, buses trains lines to this station. Also, U6 and tram lines 6 and 18 station "Burggasse Stadthalle" are close to the hotel. Furthermore, the tram lines 9 and 49 with exit at the station "Urban-Loritz-Platz" can be used.

You may return from the Banquet at your convenience using again the underground or tram lines.
